Ladders and step stools are available for reaching items overhead			
Safety stickers on ladders readily visible and in good repair			
Electrical tools and equipment properly maintained and in good repair			
Mechanical equipment, such as air compressors, properly maintained and in good repair			
Hand tools in good repair and properly stored in an organized fashion			
The correct tools and equipment are used for the job they are designed			
Extension cords free from frayed areas, have ground prong and in good repair. All worn cords discarded and replaced

Plumbed eye wash stations available and in good working repair for areas where corrosive chemicals are used/stored			
HVAC system regularly inspected and maintained in good repair			
Fire alarm and other emergency response systems regularly inspected/tested and working properly
